Registration

Registration begins on Sunday, February 5th at 10am and is taken on a first come-first serve basis. There is limited enrollment per camping session so we urge that registration be made early and for the exact number of camping periods desired. Extensions for additional sessions are not guaranteed.

Registration Discounts

Early Bird Discount – If you register between February 5th- February 19th receive a discount of \$50 off per session per child.** -OR-

Pay in Full Discount- Pay in full (upon registration) by March 31st and receive 10% off**

2nd Child Discount - \$50.00 will be applied to the second child from the same family during the same camp session.

**All discounts apply to Full Day Programs Only. Discount/coupon cannot be combined with any other discounts or offers. Transportation Excluded.

Certification

The Great South Bay YMCA Day Camp is a fully accredited member of the American Camping Association and licensed by the N.Y.S. Dept. of Health. At the YMCA Day Camp, you never have to worry about your child's safety.

Payment/Fees

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required for each session for each child. The remaining balance must be paid in full 3 weeks prior to the start of the camp session or your child will not be permitted to begin camp. There will be a \$10 fee for late payments.

Refund Policy

All deposits are non-refundable. Deposits may be used as credit when transferring camp session but will not be credited upon withdrawal. Change of session subject to availability and/or approval of camp director. There will be no pro-rating or reduction of fees based on missed days due to illness. Medical requests must have an accompanying doctor's note.

Membership Fee

All campers are required to be YMCA members at the time of registration. Membership information is available upon request at the front desk. A youth program membership is \$70.

Lunch/Snacks

All full day campers must bring a non-perishable lunch, snack and drink (lunches will not be refrigerated). Our Camp "Snack Shack" will provide snack alternatives that may be purchased for an additional fee. Please note, the YMCA is a recommended "Peanut- Free" Facility.

Financial Assistance

Financial Assistance is available for qualified individuals. Campership applications must be completed in full and received no later than May 15, 2012, for consideration by the financial assistance committee. Applications are evaluated on a first come first serve basis.

Parent Orientation Night

Join us to meet your child's camp counselor and to ask any questions you may have about your upcoming camp experience. Parents only need to attend the first Parent Information Night if their child is enrolled in multiple sessions. All orientations will follow the following format:

Session I (June 25th – July 13th) : Wed. June 20th – Kiddie–1st Grade (6pm–7pm)
2nd Grade–Teen (7pm–8pm)

Session II (July 16th – Aug. 3rd): Wed. July 11th – All Camps (7pm–8pm)

Session III (Aug. 6th – Aug. 24th): Wed. Aug. 1st – All Camps (7pm–8pm) (Directors Only)

*Parent Orientation Night is held at the YMCA facility!

Medical/Health

EACH CHILD MUST HAVE AN UP-TO-DATE PHYSICAL. This is mandated by the NYS Department of Health. A medical form will be given to you at the time of registration. No child will be permitted in camp without a completed medical form. No Exceptions! The Camp Nurse/EMT will be available during regular camp hours. Our camp is inspected and has a permit to operate from the NYS Department of Health. Off-Site Camp Directors are RTE Certified (Responding To Emergencies) which includes CPR, First Aid and AED administration.

One of our most successful programs for pre-school children. This unique experience is designed to provide both physical growth and socialization through fun-filled early childhood activities.

Campers use the air-conditioned indoor facilities of the YMCA pre-school, the enclosed outdoor playground area and have supervised access to the many activity areas of the YMCA. Activities include swimming lessons (full day only), special events, arts and crafts, music, movement and much, much more; staff/camper ratio is 1 to 5. Children eligible for Kiddie Camp must be toilet trained. **Depending on scheduling restrictions some activities may not be available for part-time campers (i.e. Inflatables, Water Play, etc.)**

TRANSPORTATION

(Ages K and up)

Transportation is available for: Youth (K-4th grade), Junior Travel (5th -6th grade), Sports, Performing Arts, Teen Travel, and CIT's. We provide door-to-door transportation for our YMCA day campers! Air conditioned mini-buses will pick up campers at their homes and drop off to the YMCA only during regular camp hours (9AM Drop-Off or 4PM Pickup). This service is not available for half-day campers, Kiddie Camp and all extended programs.
