Welcome Campers!

The Brookhaven Roe YMCA and the Patchogue Family YMCA are ready for our best summer yet! This will be our 32nd camping season and we are excited about new additions to our fun-filled program.

CERTIFICATION

At the YMCA Day Camp, you won't have to worry about your child's safety. All of our programs are carefully planned and supervised by YMCA professionals. Potential staff is subject to a criminal background check before hiring. In addition, all staff will receive YMCA camp training to ensure each camper is in a safe and well-supervised environment. Our camp is inspected and has a permit to operate from the NYS Department of Health. Each year our camp has been a fully accredited member of the American Camping Association. In 2011, we received a 100% rating for ACA.

DISCOUNTS

NEW FOR SUMMER 2012- *LOYALTY DISCOUNT Register by April 1st

At the Patchogue Roe YMCA, we love our returning campers! This new discount is available to camp families who have attended our camp for at least three consecutive summers. If your child has attended camp for three or more years, you will receive an additional \$25 off each session when they sign up for their fourth summer. Make sure you sign up before April 1st! Thank you for being a loyal part of our Y Summer Day Camp Family!

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT Register by April 1st and receive a \$25 per session "early bird" discount off of each registered session.

SIBLING DISCOUNT Register your first child and receive a \$25 per child per session discount for each additional sibling.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

REGISTRATION MUST BE DONE IN PERSON. A non-refundable/non-transferable \$100 deposit per child/per session is required upon registration. This amount is not subject to our discount. All remaining camp and extended care balances must be paid in full three weeks prior to the start of each session in order to retain your camp reservation. Balances not paid by due date will be subject to a late fee. Each child must have a Program Membership. Renewals are done at the time of registration. This \$70 fee is not included in the camp fee.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

"Camperships" are awarded based on financial need. Completed "Campership" applications must be received no later than April 15th for consideration. Applications will be reviewed on an individual basis by the Scholarship Committee. Applications received after the deadline will be reviewed as funds become available. If you would like to make a donation to "Send A Kid To Camp" please speak with a member services representative.

REFUND POLICY

Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable. Changes of sessions must be requested in writing, and require a \$15 change fee and are subject to availability. Missed days will not be prorated. Consideration may be given for medical situations. Requests must be in writing accompanied by a doctor's note and constitute a minimum of 5 consecutive missed days and is at the discretion of the Associate Executive Director. There is a \$25 service fee for any approved refund. The YMCA reserves the right to suspend or remove a child from camp – please see camp contract for additional information. Refunds will not be given wherein this decision is necessary.

HEALTH FORMS & MEDICATIONS

A Camper Health History Form must be filled out at the time of registration. NYS Department of Health requires that we have a copy of your child's updated immunizations on file. In the event you cannot drop off or mail the immunizations, feel free to have your doctor fax it to us at 289-4451 attention Leslee. No child will be permitted to attend camp and no refunds will be given if we are not in possession of this information by June 1st. Physical exams are not required. No exceptions will be made. Children requiring medication will need a doctor's note specifying proper dosage, time and procedure. Children are required to self-administer medication in the presence of the Camp Nurse. The Camp Nurse is available during regular camp hours.

CHECK- IN

The dates listed below are designed to "check in" each camper for the upcoming Day Camp session. All information must be finalized, session balances are due in full and each child will receive a camp T-shirt, session calendar, and parent booklets will be distributed.
Thursday, May 31st- all should be completed for children attending Session I
Thursday, June 21st- all should be completed for children attending Sessions II, III, IV

LUNCH & SNACKS

Campers should bring a non-perishable bag lunch, snack and a drink. Water bottles are also welcome. Lunches will be refrigerated making us unable to accommodate lunch boxes and coolers. Additional beverages and snacks may be purchased during lunch.

CAMP CLOTHING

Please dress your child for comfort and safety. Play clothes are the best. Sneakers or other closed toe shoes are a must. No flip-flops, Crocs, or sandals should be worn. Each child must have a bathing suit and towel (with their name clearly displayed) everyday. Camp T-shirts are not required every day – we encourage your child to wear their camp shirt at least the first day of each session.

Please label every item and check the lost and found frequently.

BEFORE/AFTER CARE

Extended Hours are available for all full day campers for an additional fee.

Before Care 7:00AM-9:00AM

After Care 4:00-6:00PM

Our Before Care Program is available at both our Holtsville and Patchogue locations. After Care is available at Holtsville and only for our Kiddie Camp at Patchogue.

KIDDIE CAMP [Patchogue]

(Half Day & Full Day) (3-5 years)

All children must be toilet-trained to attend Kiddie Camp.

All Kiddie Campers must be 3 before their session begins.

Kiddie Camp Hours:

Half Day: 9:00am – 12:00pm

Full Day: 9:00am – 4:00pm

Extended Hours are Available*

7:00 – 9:00 am or 4:00 – 6:00 pm

One of our most successful programs for pre-school children, this unique experience is now available to children for both half days and full days of our three week session. Kiddie Camp is designed to provide physical growth and socialization through fun-filled early childhood learning.

(Please note: the following activities apply to Kiddie campers attending 5 full days. Activities may be altered for our part-time campers.)

Activities include swimming lessons (full day only) special events, arts and crafts, music, movement, gym time, sing-a-longs, playground activities, special theme days, and much, much more. A pizza lunch will be included every Wednesday for full day campers. Kiddie Camp's staff/camper ratio is 1 to 5.

YOUTH CAMP [Holtsville]

(Grades K – 4)

Our YMCA Youth Camp encourages campers to have fun while participating in activities that develop creativity, independence and a sense of teamwork.

Youth Camp activities can include arts & crafts, volleyball, Ga-Ga, European handball, football, basketball, soccer, softball, games, theme days, water slide, sing-a-longs, carnival, miniature golf, our visiting game show, Olympics, dance, family day, low ropes course, climbing wall and, of course, swimming. A pizza lunch will be included every Wednesday. Campers will be taking trips to the Patchogue Y and the Holtsville Ecology Site.

Swimming is emphasized in our camp. Our goal is to encourage every child to learn to swim in an enjoyable manner. Instructions are scheduled three days per week and recreational swim is scheduled twice a week. All lessons are taught by certified instructors. Campers are tested on the first day and grouped by age and skill level. All children are required to take lessons unless exempt for medical reasons with a doctor's note.

CIT candidates must; submit an application by May 15th, have a letter of recommendation from one of the candidate's teachers sent directly to the Patchogue YMCA, and will be subject to an interview by our Director. Program enrollment is extremely limited.
